## **Assemblies 2016-17**

**Coppelia (K-8)** (adapted from "The Sandman," by E.T.A. Hoffman)

**The Nutcracker (K-8)**

\$450 for 1 assembly; \$600 for 2 in one day

**Music & Dance Rhythms of the World (K-12)**

\$450 for 1 assembly; \$600 for 2 in one day

\*Students will explore how history and cultures influence the music of today, and the connection between music and dance.
